

Code of Conduct

Das Progressive Zentrum is committed to creating a space where everyone can feel accepted and respected – regardless of gender identity, skin colour, religion, ethnicity, age or ability. We assume that all participants come to our events with the best intentions and respect the needs of other participants.

Therefore, we expect everyone at our events to be considerate and respectful and abide by our house rules.

The organisers reserve the right to deny access to or exclude from the event persons who have in the past made racist, anti-feminist, anti-queer, anti-trans, nationalist, anti-Semitic, ableist or other inhumane statements, or who belong to radical right-wing parties or organisations and are associated with the far-right scene, or who are conspicuous for their massively disruptive and unacceptable behaviour. Unacceptable behaviour includes abusive, intimidating, harassing, offensive, discriminatory, derogatory or demeaning acts or statements by any participant.

Consequences of Unacceptable Behaviour

Unacceptable behaviour by any participant, including sponsors and persons with decision-making authority, will not be tolerated. Should such behaviour come to our attention or be brought to our attention, we have the authority to take any action we deem appropriate, up to expulsion from the event without refund or permanent exclusion from all events organised by Das Progressive Zentrum.

If You Witness or Are Subject to Unacceptable Behaviour

If you experience or witness unacceptable behaviour – or have any other concerns and require support – please do not hesitate to report it to a member of our awareness team, recognisable by an orange coloured armband. You can also contact any other member of our team - we are wearing team badges. You can find us at the registration desk or around the venue. Talk to us anytime – we are here for you.
